Guidance for Research Proposal

- Posing a Question
 - Start with a general topic, then narrow it to a specific.
- Literature Review
 - A good research contains a review of relevant literature.
 - On-line services are useful for “lit-review.”
- Data Collection
 - A good research should be backed by available data.
 - “enough controls” is most important to a analysis.
