Guidance for Research Proposal

- Posing a Question
 - Start with a general topic, then narrow it to a specific.
- Literature Review
 - A good research contains a review of relevant literature.
 - Locate your study on academic literature.
- Data Collection
 - A good research should be backed by available data.
 - Understand that correlation and causality are different.
