1. Eligibility for Application

Applicants (regular undergraduate students) at a university that has an academic exchange agreement with Kobe University must correspond to one of the followings. *Japanese Students are not subject to apply.

- 1) Those who have graduated from high school or secondary school.
- 2) Those who have successfully completed 12 years of school education or the equivalent overseas.
- 3) Those who were approved by the faculty meeting to be equivalent to, or higher than above.

2. Application Procedure

Applicants need to provide the following documents. The documents must be submitted through your home university's appropriate section to Section of Academic/Student Affairs, Faculty of Science, Kobe University.

- 1) Application form and Curriculum Vitae (attached form)
- 2) Letter of recommendation from your university
- 3) Copy of the last diploma and Academic Record must be certified by the dean or the president of school
- 4) Photograph: Two photographs (L3cm x W2.8cm), taken within the past three months, upper-body included without hats and caps, and full face

3. Entrance Examination Fee: 9,800 yen
