Message to foreign students

- (i) Evaluation of earthquake ground motion for civil engineering works: hazard analysis, evaluation of the site amplification factor, strong-motion simulation, evaluation of design earthquake ground motion, microtremor analysis etc.
- (ii) Evaluation of earthquake response of civil engineering works: seismic response analysis considering the dynamic interaction between soil and structure, earthquake resistant design method, performance-based design method etc.
- (iii) Reliability evaluation of civil engineering works: reliability-based design, evaluation of failure probability etc.

- (ii) Research on seismic response of buildings
- (iii) Research on constitutive law of structural members
